A meeting of IQAC with the Students' Representatives held on 16.04.2016 at 2.30 p.m. Meeting room

1st Agenda: Teaching

Students reported that classes are held regularly as per the daily routine. Teachers are very much attentive about their classes.

As the University Examinations for 3rd year Honours & General classes remain suspended, through the faculties will take classes by forming special routine according to the need of the syllabus, for 2nd year and 1st year students.

Some Departments also have announced to take class tests for both the years.

Committee appreciated the views of the students about class teaching. Committee also suggested students about the daily attendance at their classes and also at the class tests for acquire knowledge and efficiency in completing syllabus and examination.

2nd Agenda: Remedial classes

Students reported on the remedial classes. Every Department has taken the remedial classes for 3rd year Honours students, 3rd year General classes were also taken in science departments. But the presence of students in the remedial classes of Arts and Commerce were not good. Committee suggested students to be attentive in the remedial classes regularly.

3rd Agenda: Project works, Excursion

Students reported that the project works of the Department of Commerce were efficiently completed by the students under the supervision of the faculties.

Excursion or the Field works of the Department of Anthropology, Botany and Zoology have been completed within the scheduled time frame, extended class teachings have done during the Field work/Excursions.

Students proposed to organize the General Excursion for college students, beyond the syllabus.

Committee resolve to approve the proposal for general excursion the guidance of at least two faculties.

4th Agenda: Committees and Cells

Students proposed to organize more number of Seminars or Workshops by the different Committees and Cells, which will be fruitful for the activities of those Cells and Committees and all students will know about the value of existence of those.

Committee approved and appreciated the proposal.

5th Agenda: Problem about the supply of water

Committee resolved that the Water Supply System and the Pumps will be checked and renovated by the formation of new system, especially at the Bioscience Departments. Committee will place the proposal to the Principal.

6th Agenda: Students' Toilet

Students placed the proposal for renovation of the toilets in the Girls' Common Room. The Students' also mentioned about the unhygienic atmosphere created by the Boys' toilets at the magement floor of the stairs. Committee resolves to place the proposal for renovation of toilets of the Girls' Common Room. Committee unanimously resolved to inform administration for shifting of the Boys' toilets from the stairs to any other convenient position.

7th Agenda: Library

Students' are satisfied with the Library service, through they need more numbers of copy of the books, journals and e-books.

Committee resolved to place their demand to the authority.

8th Agenda: Sports

Students reported on the sports activities of individual students in athletic. They placed demand for renovation of the tent of Bangabasi College at Kolkata Maidan.

Committee appreciated their demand and resolved to place the proposal to Principal.

9th Agenda: NSS

Committee proposed students to take active initiative for enrolment of more number of students in NSS unit of our Institution. Students wanted to do the programme for cloth distribution and plantation. they proposed to collect the old cloths from the faculties, Committee appreciate their proposal.

10th Agenda: N.C.C.

Students' showed their enthusiasm about the introduction of N.C.C. in our college.

Committee unanimously accepted the proposal and resolved to place it to the Principal to take initiative for implementation. Committee proposed the name of Prof. Apurba Kanti Paik (Political Science) as the mentor for this programme.

11th Agenda: Infrastructural problems for classroom

Students reported on

- a) No chair for teacher in must classroom.

- b) A table is needed at the Philosophy classroom.
- c) Repair works may be arranged for chairs, tables and benches for different classrooms.
- d) Windows at the room no. 404,401, 402 should be repaired.
- e) A nameplate for Environmental Science Department should be formed.

Committee resolved to place the demand to the Principal.

12th Agenda: Canteen
