An emergency meeting of IQAC held on 24.04.2017 at 3 pm in the Meeting Room

1. IQAC has resolved to establish An “Equal Opportunity Centre” whose aims will be to organize seminars and workshop for students, teachers and staffs, so that there may not be any discrimination on the basis of community, caste and gender.
The college must set up an “Equal Opportunity Cell” to sensitize the staffs and students on issues like gender, inclusion and environment etc.
2. Committee resolved that a strong recommendation will be placed to Principal for filling up of vacant posts of teachers in different departments.
Steps will be taken to intimate DPI, College Education, and Government of West Bengal and also to College Service Commission, W.B.
3. Committee resolved to introduce an additional skill development course for the benefit of the students. A proposal for 48 hours course in Communicative English will be placed to equip students with stronger communicative abilities for job market.
4. Resolved that the Tally Learning Programme for accountancy students may also be introduced to give students a strong foothold in the employment arena.
5. Committee resolved to organize a Green Audit to make the campus eco friendly. Green Audit of the entire college campus will be arranged by a formal mechanism by Botany Department of Bangabasi College in collaboration with the Department of Botany, Bangabasi Evening College.
6. IQAC also resolved that steps will be taken to purchase about 300 text books and 42 reference books for college library.
7. IQAC resolved that active initiatives to be taken to expedite the promotion of teachers through under CAS of 14 deserving candidates.
